Schedule Example from Previous Year

Day 1

- Tour of Pholia Dairy barn and facility
- Goat midwifery with a focus on difficult deliveries
- Milking and milk handling
- Dairy Herd Improvement milk testing
- Goat cheesemaking: Chevre

Day 2

- Finish Chevre and add seasonings
- Humane slaughter and butchering
- Field necropsy with anatomy and physiology

- Yogurt making
- Essential medical skills and supplies
- Cafeteria free-choice mineral feeding
- Goat psychology
- Hoof trimming, injections, oral meds

Day 4

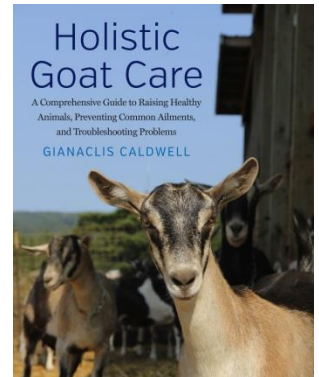
- Disbudding and Castration with sedation
